FDRL`S STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK AND PREPARATORY ACTION PLAN

Strategic Framework:

Adopting an area-based methodology, the FDRL collaborates extensively with municipal authorities and key stakeholders to address specific regional needs, with a focus on balanced and sustainable growth. The preparatory action plan prioritizes stability, economic rejuvenation, and social impact, positioning Libya for resilient recovery.

The year 2024 represent the preparatory phase focused on establishing the foundational framework as an initial step toward achieving the comprehensive vision of the FDRL. During this phase, over 2000 projects have been initiated, with more than 1,000 successfully implemented and many of them have been completed by the end of 2024.

REHABILITATION AND ONGOING INITIATIVES IN DERNA

Rehabilitation Efforts in Derna A suite of over 339 projects is currently underway in Dema, encompassing health, education, public infra structure, and housing initiatives. By the end of 2024

188 key projects will reach completion, restoring vital facilities and enhancing the city's resilience in all see tors.



REHABILITATION AND ONGOING INITIATIVES IN DERNA

Housing Initiatives:

Completion of a 2,000-unit housing project, with an additional 1500 units in progress.

Targeted support for families affected by floods, including provision of rent allowances, has facilitated the return of 98.9% of displaced residents to their homes

DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS IN BENGHAZI

Healthcare and Education Advancements:

The FDRL's healthcare infrastructure initiatives in Benghazi include the establishment of two new hospitals, alongside the refurbishment and modernization of many existing healthcare facilities.

At the University of Benghazi, 77 initiatives and projects are underway to enhance educational resources, laboratories, and essential supplies, reinforcing the city's commitment to academic excellence and leadership development, all targeted to be finalized by mid of 2025.



DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS IN BENGHAZI

City Infrastructure Enhancements:

Strategic projects include the development of Benghazi's airport, the construction of the city's third, fifth, and sixth ring roads, and enhancements to major city entrances, all contributing to strengthened connectivity and economic vitality.

The Public Housing Project is a fundamental component of the fund's strategic plan, aimed at achieving a significant transformation in housing conditions and infrastructure development in the eastern region. The project includes the completion of the Chinese Residential Buildings Project, which was relaunched on November 13, 2024, and aims to provide housing for 110,000 individuals. This initiative represents a pivotal step in the path toward urban and developmental renaissance, contributing to enhanced stability and improved quality of life in the city and the eastern region as a whole.

RECONSTRUCTION EFFORTS IN THE SOUTHWEST REGION

Southwest Region Development:

The FDRL is steadfast in its dedication to the South west region, emphasizing stability, capacity building, and reconciliation. Over 175 initiatives are focused on healthcare, education, and residential infrastructure

addressing the region's long-standing needs and bolstering human capital. The fund is committed to improving the living conditions in these neglected areas for the past 30 years.

Conducted Events:

In September, the FDRL hosted a distinguished conference dedicated to the Southwest's reconstruction. This event will illuminate ongoing projects, strategic goals, and collaborative opportunities, affirming the fund's commitment to tailored, region-specific development.

The FDRL initiated the 5,000 housing unit project in the southwest region in 2024, achieving a 75% completion rate to date. In addition to the energy project that has been launched with the objective of ensuring a reliable and sustainable electricity supply for the region.

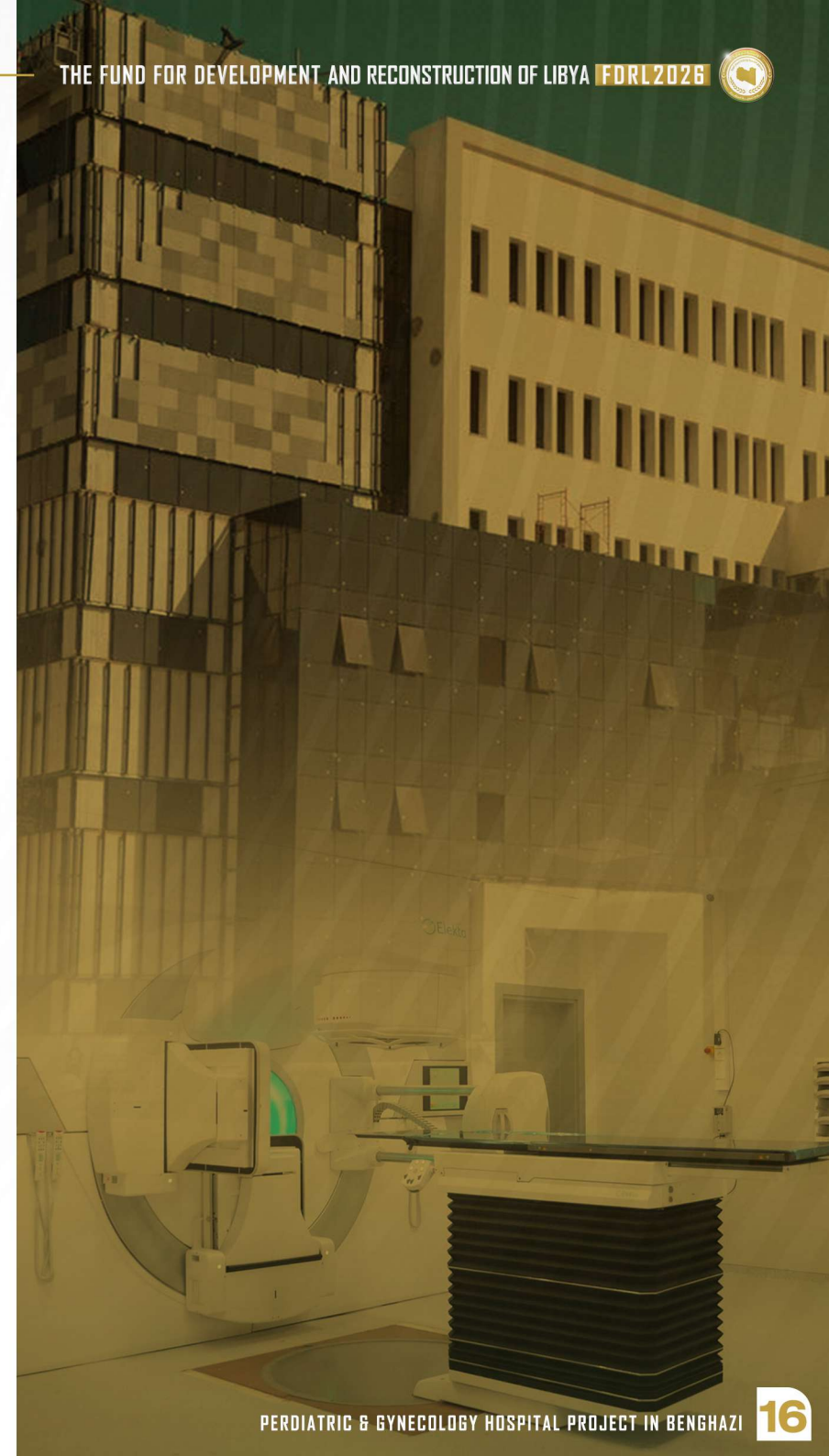

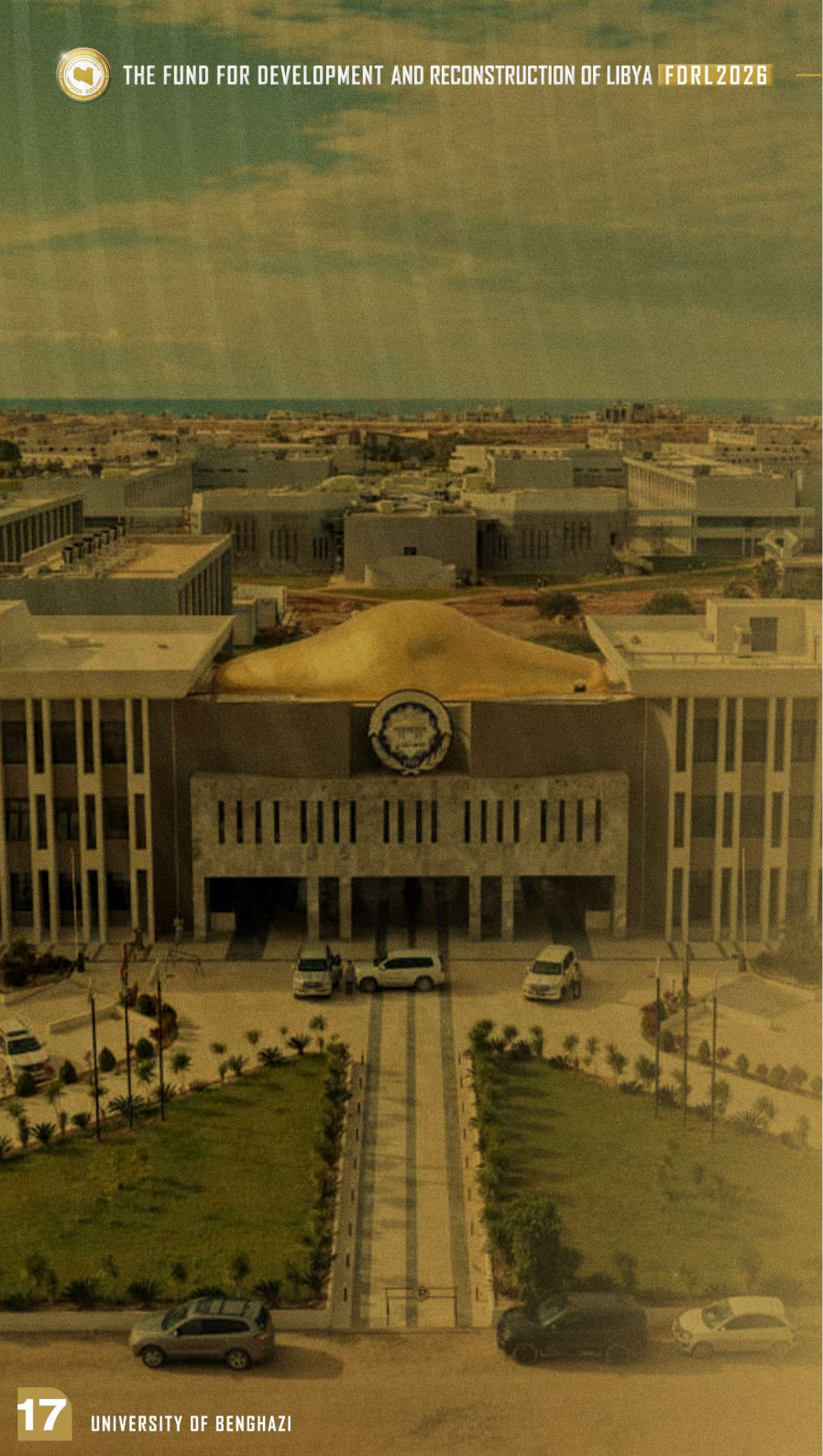

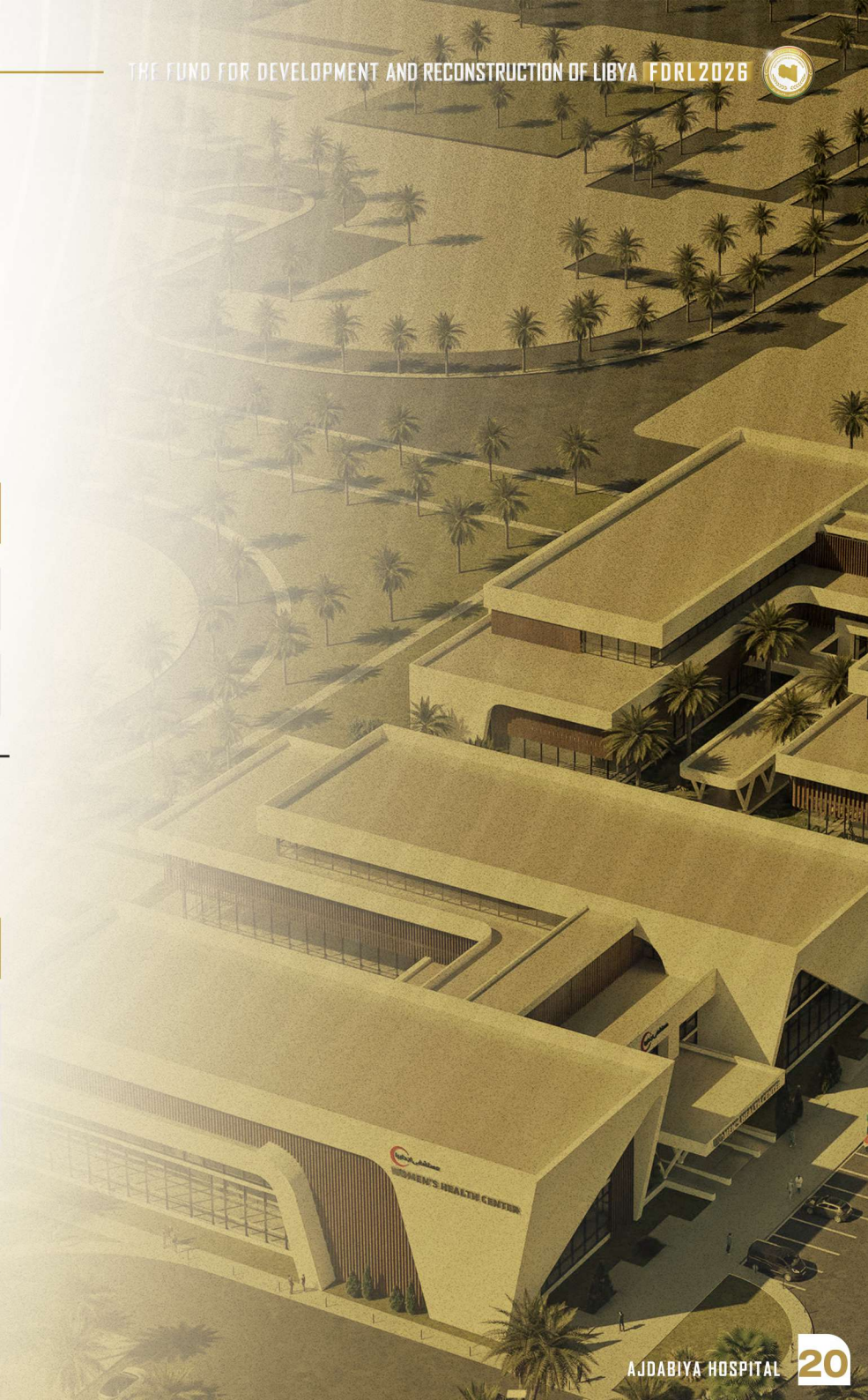
